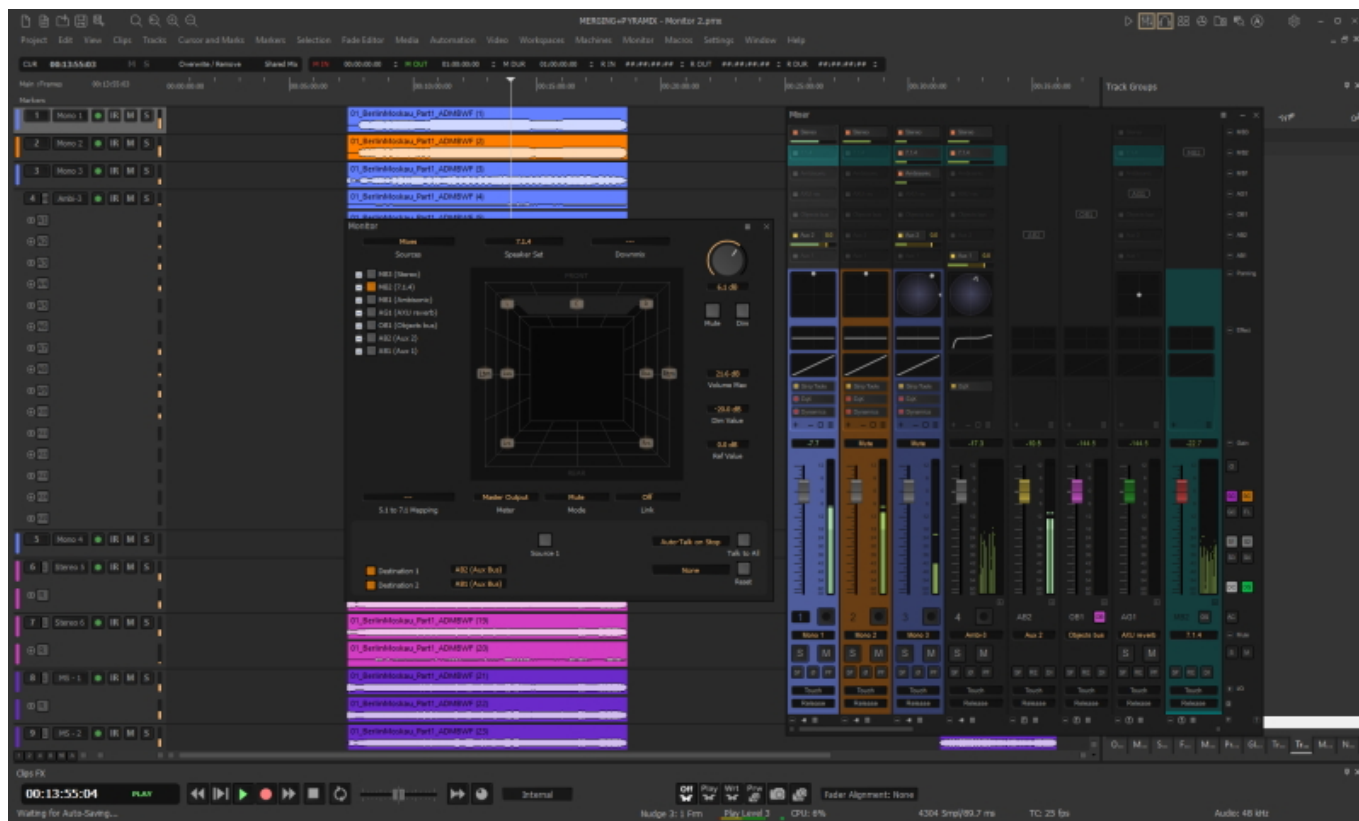


Merging Pyramix 15



Since joining the Sennheiser Group two years ago, Merging Technologies has been steadily innovating and introducing new hardware, including the Neumann MT48, Merging Hapi Mk III, and Dante options for Anubis and Hapi. Alongside these developments, the software team have been working behind the scenes to bring a major update to Merging Technologies' flagship DAW, Pyramix.

Just a week after its release, Pyramix 15 is already receiving widespread praise from professionals who appreciate its sleek, modern redesign and improved user experience. Early adopters are highlighting the revamped mixer, new Clip-Based FX, and improved monitoring features, making it easier than ever to handle complex

productions. “I am very happy about the new ARA integration, clip-based FX/processing, and the enhanced features of the redesigned mixer,” says Harald Gericke, Managing Director of PMP and Atmos Mixing & Mastering Engineer. “The flexible strip and bus placement, pinning of strips and busses, and sidechaining make it much more comfortable to mix complex projects.”

Also, the mixer is more flexible than before, saving a lot of time.” With seamless Dolby Atmos integration, a powerful real-time editor, and support for up to 384 low-latency I/O, Pyramix continues to be a trusted choice for recording, mixing and mastering engineers.

Pyramix 15 is available as a Native (ASIO/Windows-based) DAW and comes in three software packs: ELEMENTS, PRO, and PREMIUM. It can also run with the MassCore real-time engine, supporting up to 384 I/O at ultra-low latencies with RAVENNA/AES67/ST2110 compatibility.

With positive feedback from professionals already rolling in, Pyramix 15 is proving to be a strong step forward for Merging Technologies’ already trusted reputation in the world of digital audio production.
